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Requirements & Benefits for Licensed Practitioner & Board-Certified Members

Practitioner membership is opened to all individual of 21 years of age and above residing in Malaysia: -

1. Requirements for a Licensed General Practitioner member with GPL (General Practicing License)

- Completion of at least 3 MAP Accredited certification courses from MAP accredited educational institutions such as the (ICTM) Institute Federation of Complementary and Natural Medicine, (UM) University of Malaya, MTPN (Majlis Tindakan Pengguna Malaysia), HRDCorp (Human Resource Development Corporation) and IPCMU (International Psychology Complementary Medicine University) equivalent to a Master degree in Applied Psychology (including Counseling/Clinical/Health/ Educational , Psychotherapy, Counseling & Wellness Coaching).
- Have completed at least 36 clinical supervision hours with MAP accredited clinical supervisors
- Completion of the said courses will be eligible to apply for a post graduate diploma from MAP accredited educational institutions.
- Graduate of relevant degrees (Psychology, Psychotherapy, Counseling & Wellness Coaching) will be waived 1 of the said course.
- Relevant Master degree (including Applied Psychology - Counseling/Clinical/Health/ Educational Psychology, Psychotherapy, Counseling & Wellness Coaching) holder are waived 2 of the said courses.
- Relevant Doctorate degree (including Applied Psychology - Counseling/Clinical/Health/ Educational Psychology, Psychotherapy, Counseling & Wellness Coaching) holder will be eligible for the said membership without further requirement
- Members can practice general psychotherapy as stipulated by MAP codes of ethics and professional guidelines and FCNMM (Federation of Complementary and Natural Medicine, Malaysia) a designated body for professional practice by KKM
- Members are required to complete at least 12 CPD (Continuous Professional Development) points and clinical supervision hours in order to maintain and renew their annual GPL (General Practicing License & membership).

2. Requirements for a Board-Certified Practitioner

- GPL holder plus 2 level 3 or above MAP Accredited Professional Certification courses relevant to one of the specialist board which the candidate wish to apply for membership.
- Masters of relevant degree will be waived 1 MAP Accredited Professional Certification courses.
- Members are eligible to apply to be boarded as a specialist under one of the MAP specialist boards and practice as a specialist from one of the listed specialist boards as stipulated by MAP codes of ethics and professional guidelines

3. Requirements for a double Boards-Certified Practitioner member

- GPL holder plus holder of one Specialist Board-Certified membership and two level 3 or above MAP Accredited Professional Certification courses relevant to one of the further specialist board which the candidate wish to apply for membership.
- Members are eligible to apply to be double boarded as a specialist under two of the MAP specialist boards and practice as a specialist from two of the listed specialist boards as stipulated by MAP codes of ethics and professional guidelines

4. Requirements for a tripple Boards-Certified Practitioner member

- GPL holder plus holder of two Specialist Board-Certified membership and two level 3 or above MAP Accredited Professional Certification courses relevant to one of the further specialist board which the candidate wish to apply for membership.
- Members are eligible to apply to be tripple boarded as a specialist under three of the MAP specialist boards and practice as a specialist from three of the listed specialist boards as stipulated by MAP codes of ethics and professional guidelines

5. Requirements for a Clinical Supervisor member

- GPL holder plus holder of a tripple Specialist Boards-Certified membership and one level five MAP accredited professional certification course in clinical supervision.
- Members are eligible to be a MAP accredited clinical supervisor and conduct individual and group clinical supervisions as stipulated by MAP codes of ethics and professional guidelines.
